Professor Julian Rivers: Does English law need 'marriage'?

Dr Peter Saunders: The transgender agenda – critiquing its origins,

Julian Rivers has served as Professor of Jurisprudence at the University of Bristol Law School since 2007. He is an editor-inchief of the *Oxford Journal of Law and Religion* and has published widely in constitutional law, legal theory, and law and religion studies. In 2013, Professor Rivers gave oral evidence to both the House of Commons Public Bill Committee and the Joint Committee on Human Rights during their legislative scrutiny of the Marriage (Same Sex Couples) Bill.



Peter Saunders was born in New Zealand and, after medical training in Auckland, worked as a general surgeon. He has served as chief executive of the Christian Medical Fellowship since 1999 and also acts as campaign director for the Care Not Killing Alliance, a coalition of individuals and organisations promoting palliative care and opposing assisted suicide and euthanasia. Dr Saunders is in constant demand as a commentator on a broad range of issues in the field of medical ethics.
